



Ark Franklin Primary Admissions Consultation 2020/21

Ark Franklin Primary Academy is now consulting on its admissions policy for the September 2020 intake. The consultation will run until 21st December 2018.

Proposed Changes

The draft policy with the proposed changes is available on the Franklin's website. Hard copies are also available on request from the school office. The changes are highlighted on **page 6** of the draft policy.

Ark's mission is to ensure that all young people are given the opportunity to go to a great school, regardless of their background. On transition in 2013 50% of the Reception cohort at Ark Franklin were eligible for Pupil Premium, a measure of economic disadvantage, in 2018 only 7% are. As the local community changes, we want to ensure that we stay true to our mission and give families who are less well off the opportunity to attend Ark Franklin. Reflecting that, we propose to introduce an admissions oversubscription criterion that would prioritise applications for children who live close to the school and are eligible for the Pupil Premium by enlarging the catchment area for them. The oversubscription criterion for siblings of pupils will not be removed and will apply before that of the proposed pupil premium criterion.

The final admissions arrangements will be determined by the Ark Schools Management Board before 28th February 2019 and published on the school's website.
