We are learning:

To describe our own families and understand that other families can be different. To describe what we like and dislike and explain why.

You can help me at home by:

Talking about different people in my family and what they like and dislike. Using the word because to explain what you like and dislike.

Mathematics

We are learning:

To identify, describe and create simple and complex patterns. We will be learning how to reliably count objects and to start to compare different measurements.

You can help me at home by:

Asking which objects are long, longer
And longest and drawing patterns.

Outdoor learning

We are learning:

To use our environment to extend our learning through observation, exploration and investigation.

You can help me at home by:

Encouraging me to talk about how the environment is changing. This is a good chance to talk about the changing seasons. 'What are the main changes we can see?'



Expressive Art & Design

We are learning:

To draw self-portraits and pictures of each other
By using charcoal in different ways.

You can help me at home by:

Encourage me to talk about the different features on my face and their relation to each other.
Prompting me to create stories for everything I do.



Physical Development

We are learning:

To experiment with different ways of moving.
We will develop our skills in moving over, under and around and learn how to move safely.

To work at forming recognisable letters.

You can help me at home by:

Setting me assault courses and asking me to move in different ways.
Encouraging me to practise forming my letters.



Literacy

We are learning:
