
Year 1 Parent Booklet

Reading



- Develop fluency
- Build a bank of familiar stories and poems, and retell them and discuss their particular characteristics
- Recognise reading errors and self-correct.
- Predict what might happen on the basis of what has been read so far

Writing

- Embellish simple sentences using adjectives e.g. *The giant had an enormous beard. Red squirrels enjoy eating delicious nuts*
- Begin to use different types of openers e.g. *While, Where, Fortunately, Unfortunately, Sadly*
- Join words and sentences with simple conjunctions such as: *and, or, but, so, because*
- Leave appropriate spaces between words
- Punctuate sentences using a capital letter and a full stop




Mathematics

Count forwards across 100 from any given number


Add one and two-digit numbers to 20

Count backwards across 100 from any given number


Subtract one and two-digit numbers to 20

Identify and represent numbers using objects and pictures (including number lines)

Know number bonds to 10



Writing Numbers


Read and write numbers up to 20 in numerals

Find a half of a quantity

Find a quarter of a quantity



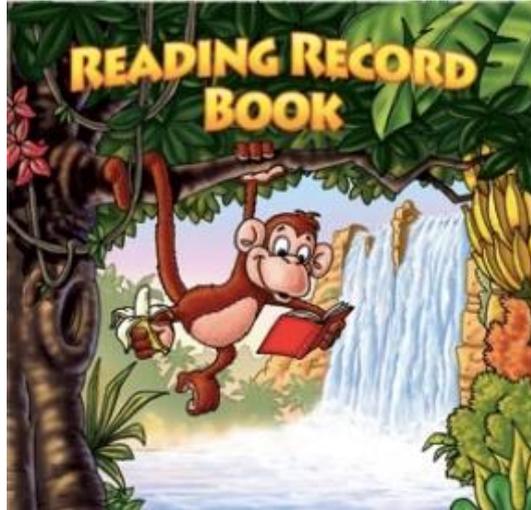
Language

Use the phrase 'equal to' accurately

Use the language of 'least' and 'most' accurately

Use the language of 'more than' and 'less than' accurately

Homework



We expect **all children** to read **out loud** for **at least** 20 minutes per night with an adult. They should then log the page that they read up to in their reading record (pictured above) and write a brief comment about what they have read. Please sign this to indicate that you have read with them that evening.



Five spellings will be sent home each week to learn. Please ensure that your child writes each spelling in a sentence in their spelling homework book.
