Another amazing week at Franklin comes to an end...

On Tuesday morning our KS2 SATs results came out for year six, we are proud to announce that the children did really well, with 84% achieving the expected standard in reading, writing and mathematics combined, well above the national average of 65%, well done year six. Coupled with 82% of our Reception cohort achieving a 'good level of development'; 98% of year one passing their phonics screener, and 80% of year two achieving the required standard in reading, writing and mathematics combined, we have had a very successful 2019 with regard to national examinations. Well done to all the children and staff for their hard work.

On Tuesday afternoon year six set out their stalls to sell the products and services they had designed, a result of their 'tenner challenge' initiative; they raised an amazing £768.61 for their end of term party.

Then on Wednesday twenty children represented us in the Ark athletics meet, the year five and six team came first, while the year three and four team came a respectable third: well done all for great sportsmanship.
