Today we are going to look at the third Ark Franklin **ARISE** value. **Integrity**. **Integrity** is a tricky word to understand. Do you remember at Nursery we used to say that **integrity** is all about **doing the right thing**. But what does **doing the right thing** mean? Integrity is not about getting your numbers **right**, or about forming your letter the **right** way.

Integrity is about a different kind of **right thing**!



Mathematics



Today you can play a game of **car park dominoes**.

You will need a large sheet of paper or an outdoor pavement to chalk on. Draw or chalk 13 parking spaces and randomly number these from 0-12. Find the dominoes you played with yesterday. You can use either your own set of dominoes or the paper set you were sent.

Carefully count the spots on each domino and park each domino in its correct parking space.

Ask an adult to check to see if you parked all your dominoes correctly, and if not then recount the spots and try again.
