Good Morning Nursery




We have yet another birthday to celebrate, as **Percy** is four years old today. Please remember to sing Happy Birthday to **Percy** today, each time you wash your hands.

Listen to this story called **Shark In The Park** which is by **Nick Sharratt**.



Why don't you try to make your own telescope out of cardboard tubes or rolled up paper? If you don't want to make a telescope, you could perhaps make binoculars instead!
