### Mathematics



Today in maths you will be looking at finding quarter of a quantity. Using a part whole model, you will be able to identify the whole using objects (cubes, beads, Lego, pasta etc). You will be able to use the steps to then quarter the quantity into four equal parts. You will be representing the whole using objects but also by drawing it onto your part whole model. You will need to pause the video when asked to and draw the part whole model on some paper for some guided examples.
