

Mathematics



Today in maths you will be using your number bonds to 10 to help you find your number bonds to 20. Solving the addition equations with your number bonds to 10. For example using the number bond 2 + 8 we can figure out 12 + 8 and 18 + 2

For this you will need something to represent the number (lego, pasta, cubes etc.) Watch the <u>link</u> for support and <u>here</u> is your worksheet.

Challenge – Can you work out what the number bonds to 30 might be? Remember if 21+ 9 = 30 we are using the number bond 1+9 and 22+ 8= 30 uses the number bond 2+8
