### Morning Message

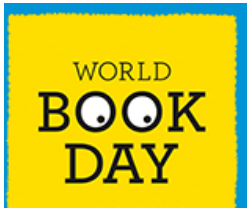


Good morning year 1 and welcome back to more home learning! Keep uploading to Seesaw, we have been LOVING your work!
