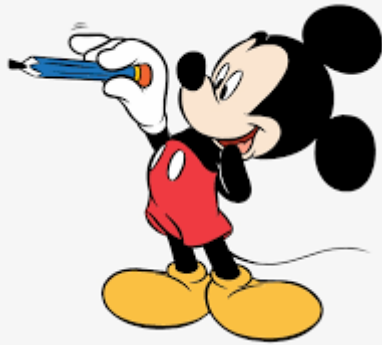
Good morning Year 2! We hope you are ready for another day of homelearning and listening to one of the Year 2 teachers reading you a story.

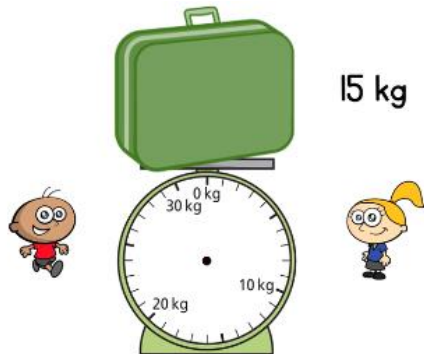

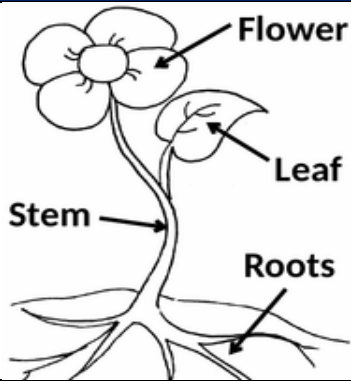

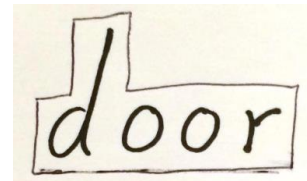
