## Writing



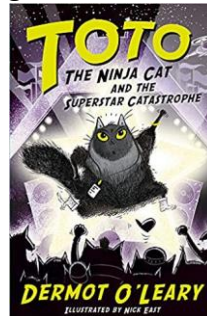
Today we are learning about exciting sentence starters, which we call adverbial sentence starters! Then, we will use them to write about the storm unicorn.
