Writing



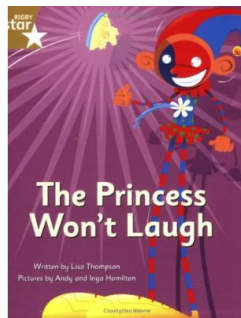
As we write the resolution today, you will need to include:
