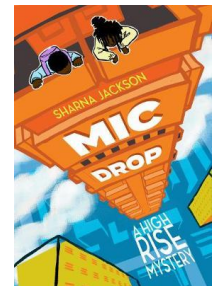


Reading

Mathematics

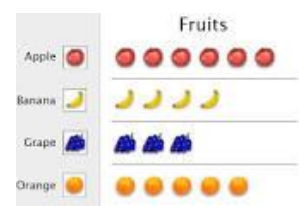
Today we'll be throwing it back right to the start of our home learning and recapping pictograms! You'll no doubt be experts in this type of data collection now 😊
