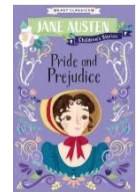


Reading

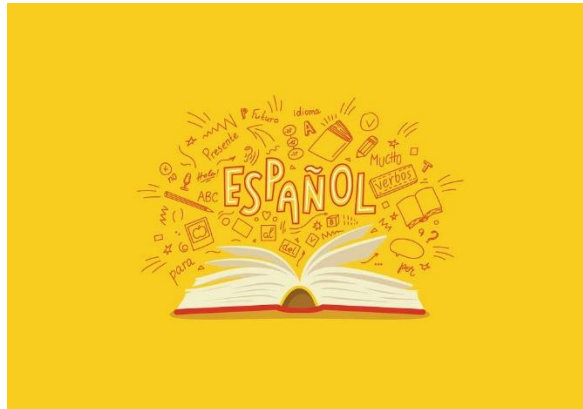
