Why not do something different this morning and take a virtual tour of Stonehenge [here](#).



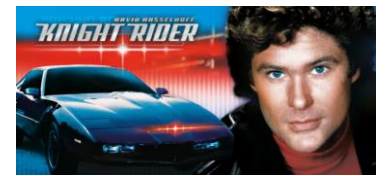

In this clip, you will see the trailer for a TV show about a high-tech spy car called KITT.

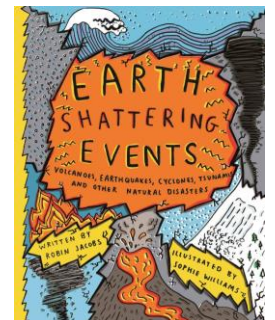

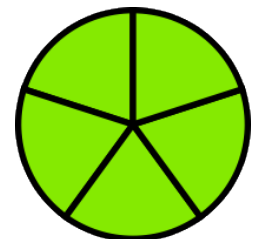
Mathematics
