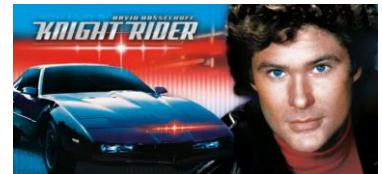

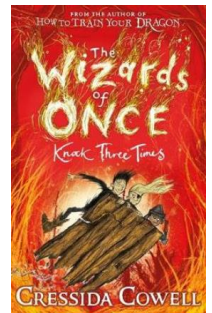

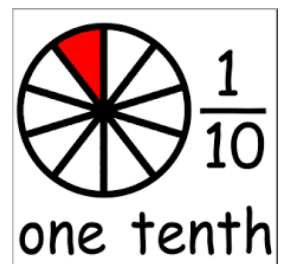


Today in our fractions unit, we'll be focusing on tenths – how many tenths make a whole?
