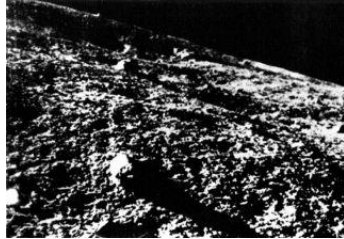




Morning Message

Remember to read the text and look for clues, as the answer is not explicitly stated in the text.

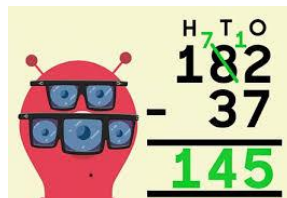
