Today's reading is from the heart- warming book called 'Saving Winslow'.

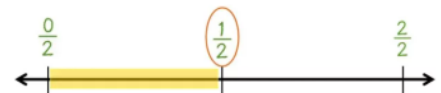
This [extract](#) describes a frail orphaned donkey which has been adopted by a kind family. Will this donkey manage to defy all odds and survive?! Read on to find out!
