Good morning Year 4 and happy 'National Carrot Cake Day'. Did you know that there are over 40 varieties of carrot?

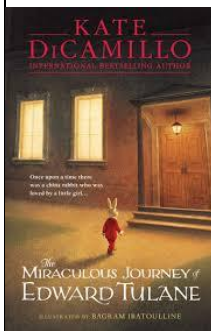
We're halfway through another amazing week of learning. Continue all your hard work and we can't wait to see what you produce on Seesaw.

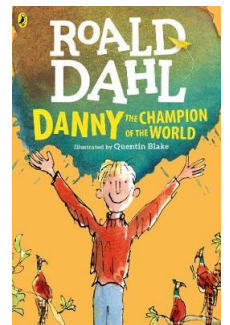
