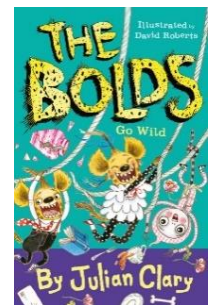
Reading

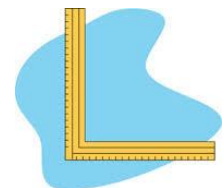
Mathematics

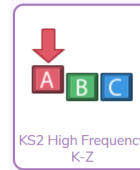
