

# Ark Franklin Curriculum Map Summer Term – Year 3

## Mathematics



**Angles and Shape:** Pupils will identify right angles and if angles are greater than or less than a right angle. They will also recognise how many right angles are in a full, half and quarter turn.

**Measures:** Pupils will explore length, mass and capacity, solving measure and word problems.

**Securing Multiplication and Division:** Pupils will deepen their understanding of multiplication and division, solve problems involving the 6- and 8-times tables, and multiply 2-digit numbers.

**Exploring Calculation Strategies:** Pupils will learn to use and apply mental strategies for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

## Art

**Collage:** Pupils will experiment with a range of collage techniques and used mixed media to create a collage portrait in the style of Arcimboldo taking inspiration from the outdoor area at Franklin.



## Computing

**Email:** Pupils will examine sending and receiving emails in a safe environment and discuss the importance of e-safety. They will also learn how to add attachments.



## R.E

**Islam and Humanism:** Pupils will explore the places of worship of Islam, how they use prayer and study a religion specific topic, whilst developing an appreciation for different beliefs and values.

## Music

**World Music - Reggae:** Pupils will develop their understanding of Reggae and produce music in this style.



## History

**The Shang Dynasty:** Pupils will learn about the Shang Dynasty and what it was like to live at that time. They will explore the life of Fu Hao and her role in the Shang Dynasty as well as looking at different artefacts to gain a better understanding of how they lived.

## Science

**Plants:** Pupils will build on their knowledge of plants from year 2, learning about the functions of each part of the plant and its life cycle.

**Forces and Magnets:** Pupils will examine which types of objects are magnetic and undertake experiments such as measuring the strengths of different magnets.



## Literacy

**Setting Description:** Based on the short animation 'The Clock Tower', the children will write a short story focusing on setting description.

**Irish Legend:** Pupils will read 'Irish Fairytales and Legends' and create their own Irish Legend based on the legend of The Giant's Causeway.

**Adventure Tale:** Pupils will write their own 1<sup>st</sup> person adventure story that is inspired by 'The Lion, The Witch, and the Wardrobe' by C.S.Lewis

**Playscript:** Pupils will learn about the specific features of a playscript and create their own scene based on the story of 'The Twits' by Roald Dahl.
