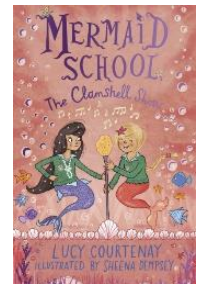


Reading

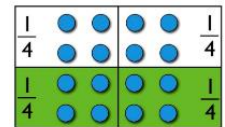
Mathematics
