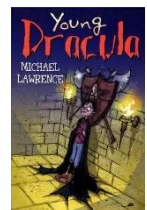
Reading

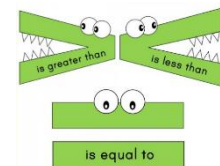
