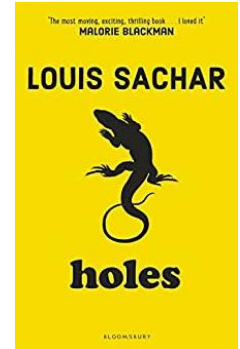
Good morning Year 5 😊
