Today you are going to write the title, engaging introduction and the equipment list. (Do not write the method yet; that will be done tomorrow).

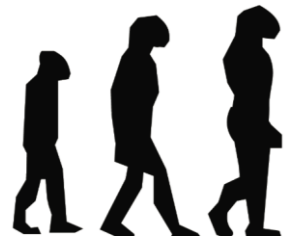
