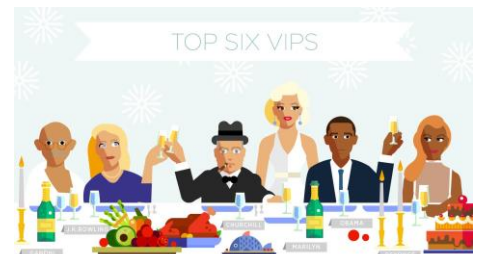
Imaginary Dinner Party
