Also, in preparation for September I am sending you an updated copy of our Parent Handbook. I would like to highlight that we will be a cashless school, meaning that wherever possible we ask that you use Wisepay, or if needs be, we can take card payments via the school office.

In-keeping with ongoing government guidance prioritising the safety of all during COVID-19, the office will only be open to visitors from 2.30-3.30pm; you may of

course continue to contact us at any time via 0208 969 3846 or using our email account [info@arkfranklinprimary.org](mailto:info@arkfranklinprimary.org) we do endeavour to reply on the same school day.

Beginning and end of day timings have changed slightly and we will not be able to offer breakfast club and after school care initially due to pod restrictions, this will be reviewed continually in line with government guidance; I am also liaising with a new provider.

All children will be asked to bring a packed lunch, along with a bottle of water and a healthy snack for break time; the guidance on keeping pods separate makes it impossible to get all 660 children through the dining room each day. Any child wishing to order a school packed lunch will be able to do so.

A survey will be emailed out next week to gauge demand for both packed lunches and after school care (so that we can look at logistics with the new provider for the latter).

We hope to be able to offer after school clubs from the end of September, as usual, this will depend on guidance regarding pod size.

At present, school lunches are provided for all, there is a charge of £2.00 a day for all children, except those in reception, year one and year two, as they are in receipt of universal free school meals; this charge should be paid in advance via Wisepay.
